### Local Rules - Main Course

#### 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- Beyond all hedges, fences, white stakes and railings bounding the course.
- The car park and all tarmac areas surrounding the clubhouse.
- Any part of the adjoining Par 3 course designated by White Posts.
- The driving range situated alongside the 1st and 2nd hole designated by white posts.
- When playing the 6th, 7th, 10th, and 18th holes on or beyond the bridleway adjacent to the holes.
- The practice putting green.
- On the 11th hole the right hand side is out of bounds as marked by white posts (not applicable on the 13th).

#### 2. Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16.1)

The following are abnormal course conditions from which relief may be taken without penalty.

- All artificially surfaced paths and winter (concrete) tee bases.
- Fixed sprinkler heads.
- Irrigation boxes.
- The water storage unit to the left of 17th and 18th holes.
- All staked trees - relief MUST be taken.
- Relief MUST be taken when a ball lies within an area marked G.U.R.

#### 3. Movable Obstructions (Rule 15.2)

- All yardage posts and fairway marker posts.

Other local rules may be displayed on the clubhouse noticeboard.

Penalty for breach of local rules:

Match Play - Loss of Hole;  
Stroke Play - 2 Strokes

#### COURSE ETIQUETTE

Players must have their own bag of clubs. Please keep pace with the group in front. Please replace divots, repair pitchmarks and rake bunkers.

Please give green keeping staff priority at all times until waved through.

#### INSURANCE & SAFETY

Everyone is advised to ensure they are adequately insured whilst playing golf. In the interests of safety, please ensure no one is in range, before playing a shot.
